

Bose Corporation – Framingham, MA (related experience with Gorman Richardson Architects)





Originally built as high bay manufacturing, the Research & Development Building has seen significant growth and numerous reconfigurations over its many years. The Bose premise of "Innovation through Research" continually requires modernization and space development. We were tasked with the challenge of reclaiming usable space to create a dynamic, easily recognizable lab that could foster the imagination. To obtain the required head height, significant infrastructure was reworked and the resultant coordination with an operational facility was a major component of the project. Natural lighting was added space through use of skylights and a new façade that recalls the adjacent Corporate Center. A 3 ¹/₂" raised floor with carpet tile was utilized to accommodate all electrical and communications and to allow for rapid relocation as the Bose work product demanded.
